Are you looking for a way to give back to your community? The Mercer County Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) is looking for individuals who are interested in volunteering their time by joining the MRC to support our community prior to, during, and after disasters.

As an MRC volunteer, you may be called upon to help during the year with routine events in our community (ex. annual flu clinic, health fair, disaster exercises, or public health outreach). Citizens without medical training are encouraged to join to assist with administrative and other essential support functions. There are no previous training requirements to become an MRC volunteer.

This is an exciting year for the Mercer County MRC as we have been awarded a grant from the National Association of County & City Health Officials (NACCHO) for training and recruitment efforts for MRC volunteers. Trainings that will be offered include Stop the Bleed, CPR, and First Aid for our volunteers.

The Mercer County Health District was also awarded a grant that allowed us to purchase a first aid tent. With this first aid tent, MRC volunteers and MCHD staff will be able to provide first aid

services in an emergency to responders and victims, during the clean-up phase. The First Aid tent will also be available for use for local festivals and events.

The Mercer County Health District is the housing agent of the Mercer County MRC and is extremely excited for the opportunities for this year. We look forward to strengthening our MRC unit!
